### What to Bring-

- Bible, paper, journal (optional), pens, pencils
- "Roughing it" clothes for 5 days
- Warm coat & Layers
- Warm PJ's
- Toiletries & towel
- Hiking shoes
- 1 set of clothes that you don't mind ruining.
- Flashlight, bug-spray, sunscreen.



- Sleeping bag, pillow, an extra blanket (optional)
- Instruments (optional)
- A positive attitude, a desire to make friends.

### What NOT to Bring-

- Guns, explosives, fireworks, alcohol.
- Electronics: mp3's, cd players, ipods, gaming devices, cell phones (there is no reception in the South Hills. Our staff will have cell phones for emergency situations. Parents are welcome to ask for these numbers.)
- **Statement regarding appropriate clothing:** This camp is focused on building healthy relationships with your brothers and sisters in Christ, and first and foremost focused on honoring God. Please do not bring anything to wear that will be a temptation for other boys or girls, or that will tempt you to show off. Please demonstrate wisdom and maturity by dressing in such a way that respects both others, and yourself. We will have extra t-shirts and jeans if any issues arise.
